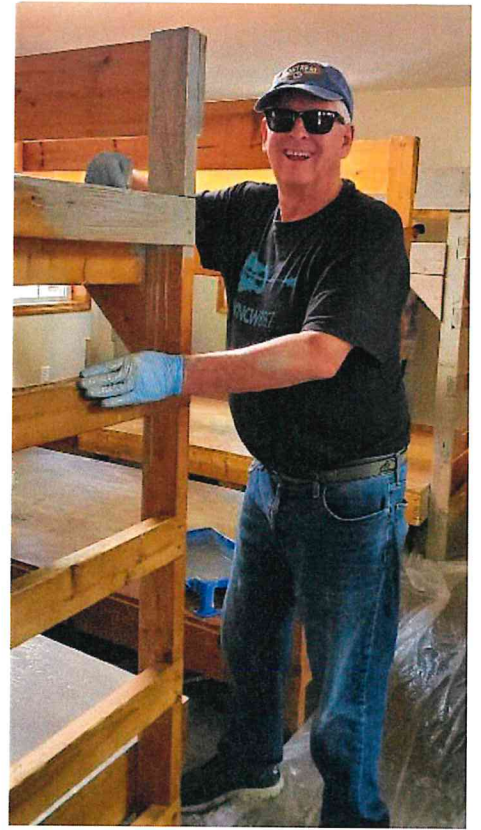


CHRISTIAN ED MINISTRY

Culdee Financial Status:

Culdee continues to be blessed with financial support and donations of time and services. The Annual Financial Review from Sandhills Accounting Services will hopefully be completed by June's end. Additional information was required from the church delaying its anticipated early-May completion.

So far this year, the Culdee Session has approved several expenses not in the budget and there were some carry over projects approved last year that have been completed this year. Not all of those projects had a financial trade-off (giving up one thing to replace with an improved option); thus, reducing or alleviating additional expense to the church.

April's financial report from Sandhills Accounting Service indicates that Culdee is \$8,124.10 over budget for the year. Income for the year is \$16,127.24 over the budget which will help during those months, like April, when income for the month is under the budget's needs. Culdee maintains a solid financial foundation. Seeking quality and economical options when future additional unbudgeted wants or needs arise will help maintain Culdee's financial health. 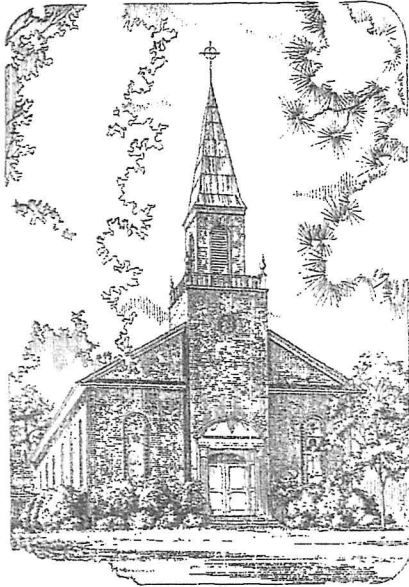
