The manse is ready for her arrival due to the diligence of Building & Grounds Elders Richard Blue and Lonnie McKenzie with the help of a host of volunteers! Thank you to all who have assisted in this preparation!

Additional Tidbits:

Jewell Vest, who has maintained Culdee for many years, will be retiring from this task at the end of June. The Finance Ministry is in the process of creating advertisements for the position and updating the job description with Jewell's assistance. Please be in prayer that the right person or service is found that will keep Culdee as nice and tidy as Jewell has done. Much appreciation goes to Jewell Vest and congratulations are extended to her on her retirement.

The annual Farm Bureau Insurance coverage rewrites have been completed, filed and paid.

Currently, Carolina Air has all HVAC systems in great working order. Reviewed was the fact that several systems are aging and Culdee's leadership must remain aware that replacing them is costly and on the horizon.

For consideration, the Harvest Festival was restarted back in the 1980s to fund Building & Grounds so that each time an item considered a capital expense (like a roof replacement or new HVAC system) had to be repaired or replaced, the congregation didn't have to be approached for more contributions to cover the cost. Later, 35% net of the Harvest Festival was earmarked for Missions. Culdee has not hosted a Harvest Festival in two years. Both Building & Grounds and Missions accounts are depleted. Please be in prayer for the Congregational Care Ministry as they determine how to proceed in regards to the October Harvest Festival and its many opportunities.

Financial Status:

The Financial Report from Sandhills Accounting Services for April 2022 showed Year-to-Date contributions are \$1,285.54 over budget needs which is good news! Unfortunately, contributions to the operations general fund did not meet budget needs for the month of April. Monthly expenses were also up.

Culdee continues to be in good shape overall. Thank you for your support of Culdee!

Finance Ministry meetings are held monthly, usually the second Sunday evening.


